**PURPOSE**  
 To introduce the art of western dressage to riders with disabilities. To use the principles and skills of western dressage to build a connection of teamwork and equitation for all test levels. Leaders, coaches, and sabb-walkers may be used in appropriate levels to help assist with safety of horse and rider. Rider must strive for the most accurate and balanced equitation to the best of their ability. The horse must show a relaxed frame of posture and willingness to take commands and correction.

 Halt 4 seconds  
 Free walk on diagonal

**DRESSAGE WALK ONLY TEST 1**

Coeli Netsky Equine Services presents - Dressage Walk Tests. These tests can be used for Senior Rider (over age 35) and Green Horse (any age), for both dressage and western dressage, small or large arena.

**Requirements:**

Straight lines, Medium walk, Free walk, 20-meter circles. Total possible points = 100.

1	A Enter medium walk	Straightness on centerline	8	str. CL halt sq + immobile
	X Halt through medium walk, salute	Quality of gait and smoothness of transition		
2	C Track right	Correct bend and balance in turn	7	Smooth-ride needs to look forward
3	B 20-meter circle to the right	Correct size, roundness, placement, and bend	6 <sup>5</sup>	too small - 20 meters
4	K X M Change rein free walk	Straightness on diagonal, forward stretch down and out, swing through hindquarters, relaxation	6 <sup>5</sup>	needs to show more stretch forward down + out
5	E 20-meter circle to the left	Correct size, roundness placement and bend	6 <sup>5</sup>	cir too small
6	A Down centerline	Straightness on centerline	8	str. CL halt sq + immobile
	X Halt through medium walk, salute	Straightness of halt, balanced, smoothness, immobile		

**Collective Marks:**

Gaits (freedom of movement)	8	free moving
Impulsion (desire to move forward, relaxation of the back)	7	forward
Submission (nose slightly in front of the vertical, acceptance of aids, ease of movements, attentiveness)	7	very attentive
Rider's Position (correct use of aids, position, and balance)	8	bal. rider

**FURTHER REMARKS**

Nice test. 20 meter circle is 66 feet around. It is exactly 1/2 the size of small dressage ring.
