Entry fees are \$25 per class through May 15. Late entries allowed May 16 through May 31 at \$35 per class. All entries must be paid no later than May 31, 2026.

Video links must be submitted no later than May 31, 2026 to info@showohsa.com.

Videos will be posted once judging is complete.

Walk Jog Trot Classes – 3 Gait riders may cross enter regular w/j/t classes.

W/J/T riders only (those who do not canter or lope) may cross enter both the regular w/j/t classes and the ONLY 2 Gait classes.

Equine Liability - By entering our online show you agree to abide by all rules. You also acknowledge that an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. Your payment (or the payment made by your parent or adult guardian) constitutes your acknowledgement and agreement of the rules and liability regulations. Membership Requirement - All competitors must be members of the Open Horse Show Association (OHSA - visit www.showohsa.com to join). All online shows hosted by OHSA qualify as competitions eligible for points toward year end awards under OHSA.

Entries - must pay all class fees on the OHSA website at www.showohsa.com under the WORLD SHOW link. Select your classes, include the names of horse and rider, and pay fees. Take videos for your classes (no still pictures accepted). Then upload your video to your youtube channel (or other online video hosting service) and email the link(s) to info@showohsa.com. Both entry fees and video submission must be provided between the first and last day of the show. Failure to do so will result in non-entry and no refunds will be given. Entries that are disqualified for any reason, either by the judge or the show will not receive a refund of any entry fees paid.

Class/Show Rules

All classes will run under OHSA rules. For classes not covered by OHSA rules the judge will refer to AQHA and/or USEF rules.

Attire – Legal attire is required for this show. See our rules document for details. This doesn't mean fancy, or blingy, just show legal, not dress down – no t-shirts or ball caps.

Unbridled classes – Shankless Showmanship means no lead rope, chain, or shank between the handler and the horse. Horse may wear a halter and lead may be looped around the neck, but handler may not touch halter, lead, or horse to complete the pattern. Ridden classes - reins may be knotted over horse's neck. Touching the reins or any part of the bridle will be cause for disqualification. Rider may use a neck rope.

Helmets are STRONGLY encouraged. If your state has a helmet law you MUST follow it as it may apply to OHSA online shows. If your state requires use of a helmet and you do not wear a helmet, you will be disqualified from that class and your entry fees will be forfeited.

Number of Horses Shown - Exhibitors may show as many horses as they wish in each class. A horse may be shown by more than one person in any class. A member may not show the same horse multiple times in the same class except for Dressage or classes that are combined seat (see below).

Dressage - you may show more than one test per seat provided the tests are different. For example, you could show in the Classic Dressage class, with an entry for First Level Test 1 and Second Level Test 2.

Combined Seat Classes – you may show a horse more than once in these classes, providing you are showing with different seats or gaits – for example, in Trail you can show as a western rider, and a hunt seat rider. Or in Bareback Pleasure you can show a horse as both a walk/trot horse and a walk/trot canter horse.

Judge's decision is final.

No refunds – for any reason other than member/horse illness/lameness verified with documentation from a licensed practicing health care provider/veterinarian.

Videos – all videos must be filmed during the month of the show. Videos found to have been filmed outside of the monthly show timeframe will cause that entry to be disqualified with no refund given.

A single video may be used for more than 1 class so long as it meets the video requirements and is taken during the correct timeframe. For example, if you enter Adult Western Pleasure and Western Horsemanship Rail you may use the same video if you choose. However, if you enter Western Pleasure and Walk Jog Western Pleasure you cannot use the same video.

Review the requirements for each class in the Show Rules document and make sure your video will meet those requirements. (i.e., length of time, views, gaits, etc). You may be disqualified for failing to meet video requirements at judge's discretion. Videos should not be set to music and they must not be muted, except for dressage and reining freestyle classes.

Videos found to be edited will result in the member and horse being disqualified from every class in the show. Entry fees will be forfeited. Video editing includes stopping and restarting the filming of the video. Videos must be one continuous video.

It is highly recommended that all rail classes be videoed from the middle of the arena and pattern classes should be videoed from one of the long sides of the arena. Dressage should be videoed from C. If you do not have an arena, any relatively flat area (including pasture) will work – just ensure it is free from distractions (jumps or trail obstacles set up in the arena are fine, but remember that you must be able to be seen in the video) and tall grass may hinder the judge's ability to view you and your horse's work.

Awards

Class Awards - Belt buckles awarded to class winners of classes with 10 or more entries. Neck sash ribbons or similar awarded to class winners of classes with 9 or fewer entries. Rosettes or similar for placing 2nd to 6th. Buckles may also be purchased for any placing at a discounted rate of \$100 (this includes shipping).

Division Awards - All divisions with 10 or more total entries within the division will qualify for a high point and reserve high point award. The high point champions and reserves will be determined by the number of points earned (points awarded based on OHSA standard points table – see Member Rulebook). Special awards will be given for division high points and reserve high points.

Exhibition Awards - special awards will be given to 1st to 6th place for all exhibition entries. Awards may be flat ribbons and/or other awards.

Special Awards

DC Injusto Young Horse Challenge – in memoriam of one of OHSA's yearling horses that passed last year. All in hand classes count toward this special circuit award. Horses can be weanlings, yearlings, or 2 year olds – age as of 1/1; born on or after 1/1/24). Riding classes will not count.

Firefly Mini Horse Award – In memoriam of one of OHSA's first horses enrolled in our organization, Whinny For Me Firefly, we will give a special award for the mini shown in the circuit with the most overall points. To qualify the horse must be either registered with a miniature horse association or measure no more than 34" measured at the base of the last hair of the mane.

The Austin Senior Horse Award– In memoriam of one of OHSA's senior horses, Austins Painted Eeyore, owned and loved by Kim Betros. Austin was the overall year end winner in 2023. He passed away in 2024 and will be missed by many. OHSA will give a special award for the senior horse with the most overall points. All horses age of 20 and over qualify for this award. All classes will count.

Videos must be filmed within the dates of the show with the link emailed to info@showohsa.com. Videos should be clear and include you and your horse within the frame as much as possible, as close as possible. Remember that the judge can only judge based on what they can see, so make sure they can see you! Review the Show Rules document for all video requirements and judging standards.
