You acknowledge that equine activity sponsors or professionals are not liable for injury or death resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. Payment (by you or your parent/guardian) constitutes acknowledgement and agreement to these rules and liability regulations. Membership Requirement

All competitors must be current members of the Open Horse Show Association (OHSA). You can join at www.showohsa.com. All OHSA-hosted online shows qualify for points toward year-end awards, although some classes may not qualify.

Entries

To enter, pay all class fees on the OHSa website under the ONLINE SHOW link. Select your classes, include horse and rider names, and submit payment. You must record videos for your classes, with still photos accepted only for the Fun class. Upload your videos to YouTube or another hosting service, then email the link to info@showohsa.com. Both entry fees and video submissions must be completed between the first and last day of the show month. Failure to meet deadlines results in non-entry, and no refunds will be issued. Entries disqualified by the judge or show management will not receive refunds.

Class and Show Rules

All classes will be conducted under OHSa rules. For any classes not specifically covered by OHSa rules, the judge will refer to AQHA and/or USEF rules as applicable.

This circuit is a dress-down event, so participants are welcome to wear casual attire such as t-shirts, jackets, ball caps, or knit caps. Show attire is optional; however, boots and long pants or breeches are required for all classes. While the dress-down policy allows for casual wear, maintaining a neat and clean appearance is important as it creates a positive impression. Helmets are mandatory for all over-fences classes and in any locations where helmet use is required.

Exhibitors may show as many horses as they wish in each class, and a horse may be shown by more than one person in any class. However, a member may not show the same horse multiple times in the same class, except in Dressage or combined seat classes.

In Dressage classes, you may enter more than one test per class as long as the tests are different. For example, you could compete in the Dressage class with entries for both First Level Test 1 and Second Level Test 2.

For combined seat classes, a horse may be shown more than once provided it is shown with different seats or gaits. For instance, in Bareback Pleasure, a horse can be shown as a walk/trot hunter horse, a walk/trot/canter hunter horse, a walk/jog western horse, and a walk/jog/lope western horse.

The judge's decision is final in all matters.

No refunds will be issued except in cases of member or horse lameness or illness with verified documentation.

WHAT'S NEW!

The 2026 season brings several updates designed to improve clarity, fairness, and exhibitor experience. Classes may now be divided into Adult and Youth sections when each group has at least six entries. (6 adult AND 6 youth)

New Premier Classes have been added, offering patterns that are slightly more challenging than standard classes, and cross-entry is permitted.

Mini and Pony Conformation has been bundled with aged conformation classes, and exhibitors may enter only one of the four aged/mini conformation options.

Color Class now includes a companion Solid Color class for horses that are not considered color breeds—specifically those that are not Appaloosa, Paint/Pinto, Buckskin, or Palomino.

Western Road Hack has also been introduced as a new western class, judged on forward motion, smooth gaits, and the horse's ability to travel long distances comfortably.

Ground Poles has expanded into multiple divisions. Traditionally a Hunt Seat class for riders beginning their over-fences journey, it is now available in Western, Fine Horse, and additional divisions to support foundational training across disciplines. Year-end points for Ground Poles will be awarded only in Hunt Seat and WT Hunt Seat.

Dressage Equitation will now include a posted pattern.

The Driving division has been removed from Fine Horse so minis can compete on equal footing for division awards.

Some Fine Horse classes, such as Fine Horse Trail, will now combine Saddle Seat and Side Saddle entries.

In the Non-Equine division, the handler must be an OHSa member, but the animal does not need to be registered with OHSa.

Finally, to qualify for a circuit division award, exhibitors must show in at least one riding class within that division, with the exception of the In-Hand division.

Videos – All videos must be filmed during the month of the show. Any video determined to have been recorded outside the designated monthly timeframe will result in disqualification of that entry, and no refund will be issued.

Exhibitors are responsible for providing proof of the video date, either by using the phone's built-in date/time stamp, showing a handwritten date to the camera at the start of the video, or verbally stating the date before beginning the ride.

Music should not be included in your videos, even if as background "barn" radio noise. We have had member videos removed from YouTube from various recording studios and their attorneys for violating copyright laws. If your video is removed we may not know until after the deadline to submit videos. OHSa will have no recourse other than to disqualify you for not having a viewable video.

A single video may be used for more than one class as long as it meets all video requirements and was recorded within the correct timeframe. For example, the same video may be used for both Adult Western Pleasure and Open Western Pleasure. However, a video used for Western Pleasure may not be reused for Walk-Jog Western Pleasure, as the class requirements differ.

Exhibitors should carefully review the Show Rules to ensure their video meets all class-specific requirements, including length, required gaits, views, and any pattern elements. Videos set to music should not be submitted. Freestyle or "your pattern" classes must include all required movements. Failure to meet class requirements may result in disqualification at the judge's discretion.

Videos that show any form of editing—including stopping and restarting the recording—will result in the member and horse being disqualified from all classes in that show, with all entry fees forfeited. Videos must be recorded in one continuous, unedited take.

If an arena is not available, any reasonably flat area may be used, including a pasture, provided it is free of major distractions and allows the judge to clearly see the horse and rider. Tall grass or poor visibility may hinder judging. Pattern classes requiring markers must include cones or other safe markers; failure to do so may result in disqualification.

Finally, exhibitors should ensure their videos are clear and properly framed. Videos that are too far away, too dark, overly bright, or otherwise difficult to view cannot be judged accurately. Give yourself the best chance for fair evaluation by submitting a clear, well-lit, and properly zoomed video.

FREESTYLE (YOUR PATTERN) Classes

You must send in the pattern you are riding in Freestyle and "Your Pattern" Classes. It can be typed into your email, attached, and be written or drawn.

For Dressage Tests, you can submit the Test Title (ex: USDF Training Level Test 1) or the full test. Tests should be from the current tests available. You can submit tests from USEF/USDF; WDAA; Netsky; RedRosettes; and FEI.

Videos must be filmed in the month of the show with a date stamp. Email the link to info@showohsa.com. Videos should be clear and include you and your horse within the frame as much as possible, as close as possible. Remember that the judge can only judge based on what they can see, so make sure they can see you! Review the Show Rules document for all video requirements and judging standards. Failure to follow video requirements may be reflected in your scores and placings.

Circuit Awards

All awards are based on horse/rider combination. Entries will receive circuit end high point rosettes or similar. No individual monthly class awards will be given. \$2 and free classes are excluded from all awards but some may be eligible for year end points.

High Point and Reserve High Point awards will be presented across several special categories and circuit divisions.

OHSA also offers memorial awards honoring horses who made a lasting impact on the organization. These include:

The DC Injusto Award – created in memory of the young horse DC Injusto, recognizes the horse with the highest points earned in all in-hand classes. Eligible horses must be weanlings, yearlings, or two-year-olds born on or after January 1, 2024; riding classes do not count toward this award.

Firefly Mini Horse Award – honors Whinny For Me Firefly, one of OHSA's earliest miniature horses. This award is presented to the mini with the highest overall circuit points. To qualify, the horse must either be registered with a miniature horse association or measure no more than 34 inches at the base of the last hair of the mane.

The Austin – commemorates Austins Painted Eeyore, the 2023 overall year-end winner. This special award is given to the senior horse—age 20 or older—with the most overall points, with all classes counting toward the total.

Additionally – OHSA will designate two more buckle divisions at the end of the circuit based on which remaining divisions have the highest overall entry numbers.

Buckles for High Point and Reserve High Point may be purchased by exhibitors who earn a high point or reserve title in a division that does not award a buckle. The cost is \$100, which includes shipping, with an estimated delivery time of six to eight weeks.

High Point, Reserve High Point, and placings to Sixth receive Large Rosettes, Neck Sashes, Trophy, or similar awards to all divisions not deemed to be buckle divisions.

Circuit Class Awards – First through Sixth

Awarded based on circuit points by class. Rosettes or similar awards. No individual class ribbons by show will be awarded.
